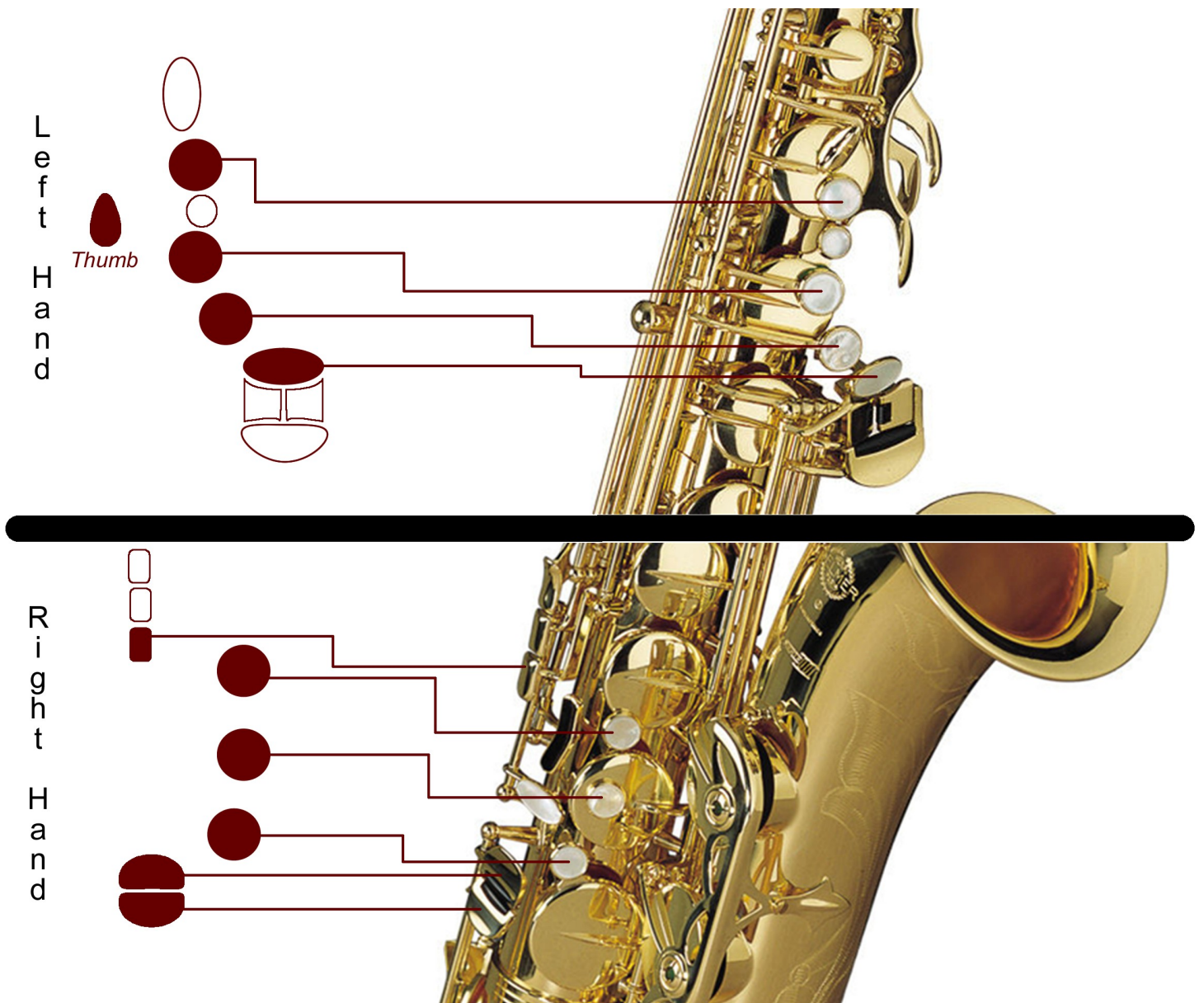


Simple Saxophone Fingering Chart
